• **FleadhFest** is the big news for 2021. One venue on the island of Ireland will be selected to host this national Fleadh extravaganza next August. It will be a virtual/factual celebration of 70 years of the Fleadh story. It will link with millions of Fleadh fans worldwide. It will be preceded by a **FleadhFest** in Counties and Provinces. BE IN TUNE WITH FLEADHFEST!

- FleadhFest in 2021 promises to be one of the most interesting and comprehensive cultural responses to COVID-19 nationwide and among the Irish diaspora. It is organised by the Irish cultural movement Comhaltas Ceoltóirí Éireann which operates in each County in Ireland and in 18 countries worldwide.
- FleadhFest will link the Irish fireside with the world stage. Fleadh Cheoil na hÉireann in 2019 had an attendance of 750,000 people. FleadhFest will build a bridge of renewal with millions of Fleadh fans worldwide.
- FleadhFest will give each County, Province and Comhaltas worldwide the opportunity of telling it's story, introducing their favourite musicians, singers, dancers, poets, storytellers, sports heroes, An Ghaeilge, Cultural Centres and archive footage to our world neighbours. It places Comhaltas at the heart of the community.
- The format is a two-hour planned, researched, scripted, presented and pre-recorded presentation to be transmitted on the appropriate social media platform.
- At the conclusion of FleadhFest all the County presentations will, in years to come, when assembled for Cultúrlann na hÉireann, form a historical record of the Comhaltas resilience and response to COVID-19.
- **TREOIR GAN DEOR!** There is a seanfhocal which tells us Tamall gan treoir tamall na ndeor. (Time without direction is a time of tears). Have you received your copy of the Comhaltas TREOIR? The Branch Subvention Scheme is helping such branches over the line to ensure their future in brighter times. It has also been agreed to extend the registration date for Branches. - Our COVID-19 contact Ronan O' Brien, based at Brú Ború in Cashel, reminds us that as of midnight Wednesday 21st October all counties in the Republic of Ireland have moved to Level 5 of the Medium-Term Plan for Living with COVID-19.

As an organisation we have consistently acted with what has been in the best interest of all concerned, with particular consideration given to the safety of all our members and the wider general public.

We are asking all units to continue the suspension of all indoor activities while under Level 5 restrictions.

Furthermore Comhaltas Guidelines and Communications distributed to Comhaltas units are based on Government Guidelines in the Republic of Ireland. All units should first and foremost adhere to the guidelines issued by the jurisdiction they are governed by.

The focus for the MEITHEAL Team of the future will be ATHNUACHAN – Renewal ar AN RÓD SEO ROMHAINN.

Last March, the Buanchoiste were mandated by the Ardchomhairle to monitor and respond to the challenges of COVID-19. Yes, it has been a strange and, at times, difficult task.
