- AN tOIDEACHAS SA CHOMHALTAS.... In recent times, there have been giant steps on the education front. Here from Majella Bartley is a taste of what is to come:

We in Comhaltas are currently finalizing our stage one 'Initial Access for Provider' application for QQI accreditation. This application when approved will deem CCÉ a QQI provider. As part of this process, our governance and structures have been developed to align with QQI procedures. At the top of the pyramid we have established an Executive Committee, which is an oversight committee. All other boards and committees report to the Executive Committee and the executive reports solely to the Coiste Oideachais; Other boards/committees are as follows;

- PLC Board which works directly with the PLC in Performance and Education
- SCT/TTCT Board who develop and oversee the running of the SCT exams and the TTCT including the TTCT Preparatory course.
- Quality Committee to make sure we are compliant with all procedures and regulations defined by QQI. The external examiner also reports to this committee
- Programme committee to continue to develop current and new courses and programmes
- Examination/Results committee who oversee the overall examination process and make sure results are verified.

We are also currently developing our IT structures, our key elements are;

- 1. Comhaltas Education Website to act as an entry pathway to all educational programmes
- 2. Educational Management System with front and back-end functionality
- 3. e-learning platform for delivery of educational modules

Developing these IT structures is essential to the success for our educational programme.
