



COVID-19 UPDATE FOR COMHALTAS

FEBRUARY 28th 2022

Comhaltas Guidelines and Communications distributed to Comhaltas units are based on Government Guidelines in the Republic of Ireland. All units should first and foremost adhere to the guidelines issued by the jurisdiction they are governed by.

With effect from Monday 28th February:

- **the mandatory requirement to wear face masks will be removed, while the public health advice that masks should continue to be worn on public transport and in healthcare settings remains.**

The government has agreed that the following public health advice will continue to be important:

- **continuing infection prevention and control measures including in relation to ventilation, hygiene measures and advice to stay at home if symptomatic.**

We would ask all units and members to continue to exercise caution and implement recommended public health advice including washing of hands, sanitising stations, cleaning schedules, ventilation etc. to continue to ensure the safety of our members and the general public.
