

SCT Information

Registration

The registration period for the SCT Exams each year is between November and mid January.

The closing date for registrations and payments are posted to the Comhaltas blog and the SCT Facebook Page once the registration period begins. Entries and payments received after these closing dates will not be accepted.

You will also find the link to register online for the exams.

After you have registered your details you will receive an email containing a link to activate your account. Once your account is active you can login using your email and password and enter any students you have during the registration period. You can select your nearest exam centre from the dropdown box when entering online.

Alternatively, the application form is available online. This can be posted to the above address along with the payment.

Payment

Payment can be made online through PayPal by logging into your PayPal account and sending the payment (please reference your Application Number) to sct@comhaltas.ie

Alternatively you can pay by cheque, postal order or bank draft made payable to Comhaltas and posted to Clasac, Alfie Byrne Road, Clontarf, Dublin 3, D03 H973.

Exam Dates

The exams take place Mon-Sun from 09:30am-05:30pm between the end of March and early June including the Easter holidays. You cannot pick your own exam date. You will receive a minimum of 14 days notice for your exam.

Senior Exams

Research projects for Grade 6,7 & 8 must include a fully completed cover sheet. They must be submitted by email to sct@comhaltas.ie by 5pm on March 1st. Alternatively they can be uploaded on the SCT exams website.

From 2020 onwards all candidates applying for the Advanced Performance Certificate, regardless of when they took their Grade 8 examination, must have scored a minimum 54 out of 60 marks (Distinction) in the Performance section of their Grade 8 exam along with a minimum Honours grade overall.
